Formatting a Paper for APA 6 th Edition

APA recommends that your title be focused and succinct and that it should not contain abbreviations or words that serve no purpose. Your title may take up one or two lines. All text on the title page, and throughout your paper, should be double-spaced. Beneath the title, type the author's name : first name, middle initial(s), and last name.

APA Style uses two types of capitalization for titles of works (such as paper titles) and headings within works: title case and sentence case. In title case, major words are capitalized, and most minor words are lowercase. In sentence case, most major and minor words are lowercase (proper nouns are an exception in that they are always capitalized).

Note: All citations should be double spaced and have a hanging indent in a Reference List. A "hanging indent" means that each subsequent line after the first line of your citation should be indented by 0.5 inches. According to APA rules, the title that appears in the header of your cover page (Running head: TITLE) and subsequent pages (TITLE) cannot exceed 50 characters including spaces and punctuation. In addition, it is recommended that titles never exceed twelve words. When the title is more than 50 characters, titles should be shortened.
