Between 2006 and 2016, the built area of Addis Ababa increased from 24,942 ha to 35,050 ha. This represents rapid urban expansion of approximately 2% per year. The city's overall density (built area/person) decreased between 2006 and 2016 from 109 people/ha to 98 people/ha.
