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Motorcycle Carb Tuning Guide

Carb floats control the fuel level in the carb bowls. The motorcycle shop manual will specify the correct fuel level for your bike. The best way to measure the fuel level is with the clear tube method. If your fuel level is too low, you might be running lean. If it's too high, you might be running rich and fouling your oil with gas.

Download the Carb Tuning Guide Watch the Super E & G Carb Basic Setup video. Verify carburetor is set to stock settings: Idle mixture screw, 11/4 turns from lightly seated. Idle speed screw, ½ turn clockwise from engagement point. Accelerator adjustment screw, two turns counter-clockwise from seated. Start bike, bring to operating temperature.

Motorcycle carburetors take in air and mix it with fuel. Numerous factors can throw a motorcycle carburetor out of tune. Typically, motorcycle carburetors are shaken out of tune by vibration. Manufacturers like Mikuni, Keihin and S & S sell original equipment and aftermarket carburetors for numerous motorcycles.

Some carburetors have a slow speed fuel adjusting screw that regulates the fuel/air mixture in the lower rpm range. Others have an air adjusting screw. Turning this screw clockwise will reduce the amount of air entering the carburetor, and will, therefore, richen the mixture (refer to a shop manual for correct settings).

Needle-Height Tuning Adjustment Motorcyclist When someone says drop or lower the needle, that means a leaner setting. Raise the needle for a richer mixture. This is fine-tuning your carburetion in...

Inside A Motorcycle Carburetor - Needle-Height Tuning ...

Carburetor diameter (12mm) x 5 = 60 (or number it calculates) x 0.9 = sea level jet size. For Denver: Take 0.948 (Denver atmospheric pressure at 70 degrees) x jet size (60) = new jet size (56.88) round up 57 would be the proper jet size to start at for a stock scooter using a 12mm carburetor.

When installing new carbs, you'll find in almost every case, the throttle slide on one carb will be lower than the other carb. It's usually easiest to adjust the carb with the lowest slide. Note: If your carbs are opposite from the carbs in the picture above, just close the throttle and reopen it until the slide on the right carb just touches the top of the intake bell and use this same procedure described below.

The most important part of rejetting carbs is the main adjustment because the main jets are influencing all other adjustments. The main jets regulates the air/fuel mixture when the throttle is fully opened (braaaaaaaaaaaaap!!). 1/4 to 3/4 throttle are regulated by the gas needle.

With the engine running try turning the idle speed screw (throttle stop) in until the engine maintains a constant rpm without throttle input, then turn the screw out until you get the desired rpm or engine speed (aprox 1,000 rpm, by ear). If this isn't the problem, then I can help you move the the next step.

How to: Idle mixture screw adjustment - The Junk Man's ...

The grade of spark plug recommended by the motorcycle manufacturer is an important base-line for carburetor tuning. If you are fouling the recommended spark plug you should never change to a hotter grade plug in order to correct the problem. With Amal, and most Mikuni carburetors, you are dealing with instruments that have multiple tuning stages.

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
