The tabernacle in the wilderness was a portable place of worship God commanded the Israelites to build after he rescued them from slavery in Egypt. It was used from a year after they crossed the Red Sea until King Solomon built the first temple in Jerusalem, a period of 400 years.

### The Tabernacle - Where God Lived Among His People

The Tabernacle building itself stood at the West end of the court and was a wooden structure overlaid with gold 45 x 15 feet divided into two parts by a heavy curtain called the "Veil." The entrance was a multicolored curtain door hanging on 5 pillars.

Bible History Online - The materials that God ordered in constructing the Tabernacle were gold, silver, and bronze; "blue, purple, and scarlet thread, fine linen, and goats' hair; "ram skins dyed red, badger skins, and acacia wood; "oil for the light, and spices for the anointing oil and for the sweet incense; "onyx stones, and stones to be set in the ephod and in the breastplate.

### The Holy Materials Used in the Building of the Tabernacle ...

The actual Tabernacle "house" is made up of board walls covered in gold, and a tent roof. It is the inner rectangle which has two compartments. One is called the "Holy Place" and the smaller one is called the "Holiest Place." The two rooms are separated by a veil. There is only one entrance to each of the three sections.

Things get really tedious in Exodus 25, what with all of the detailed instructions for everything having to do with the tabernacle. And these detailed instructions go on and on and on (with only one interesting break in the tedium), all the way through chapter 40. Thirteen of the forty chapters of Exodus are about the Tabernacle.

### Why is so much of Exodus Spent on Instructions Concerning ...

What Did the Tabernacle Look Like? In Exodus 27:9-19, God gives specific instructions for the construction of the Tabernacle. Although not as complex or ornate as the Temple, God laid out specific measurements and structures found within the Tabernacle. A rectangular fence surrounded the Tabernacle. In the courtyard, between the fence and the tent (Tabernacle), you had the bronze altar (where they would perform sacrifices) and bronze laver (where the priests would wash their hands).
