In antiquity and the High Middle Ages, there were different ways of teaching young men at the university. The trivium was three simplest ways to study the world, and so young men learned them first. After the trivium, they studied the quadrivium. Together, these subjects were called the seven liberal arts. The most difficult, and final subject studied was theology. The ...

A 15th century English translation of Ranulf Higden mentions the arte triviale, referring to the trivium of the Liberal Arts. The same work also calls a triviale distincion a threefold division. This is due to an application of the term by Arnobius, and was never common either in Latin or English.

The trivium, which is part of the 7 liberal arts, was first used in antiquity and then adapted to suit Christian medieval times.
