We can configure currencies as per the rules of the country defined in the company code. SAP provides currencies of every country and we can also define our own currency if we require. In SAP, when we define Company/company code, currency is a basic data which should be maintained.

The local currency is the currency of the company code which represents the legal entity in a 'standard' SAP configuration. This currency is used to comply with local tax reporting requirements as well as representing the functional currency as seen in FAS 52 or IAS 21.
